Hire the Reading Room

Rathmell Reading Room is available for private hire at just £12 per morning, afternoon, or evening session, or £20 for two sessions.

The Reading Room's maximum capacity is fifty people. The space is suitable for workshops, classes, talks, meetings, presentations / film screenings, family gatherings, musical events, children's parties, table sales, coffee and cake mornings... and more.

An upstairs room with a full-size snooker table can also be hired on request.

The Reading Room is located in the centre of Rathmell village, just over the road from both Holy Trinity church and the Methodist Church, and within easy walking distance of the Old Primary School. The Reading Room has its own small car park to the rear, with the village car park twenty metres away
